FAIR WINNER

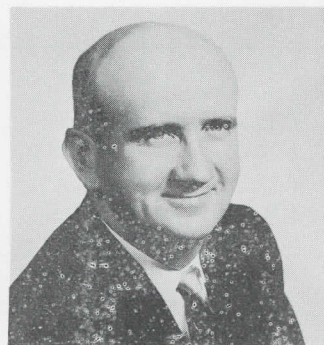
