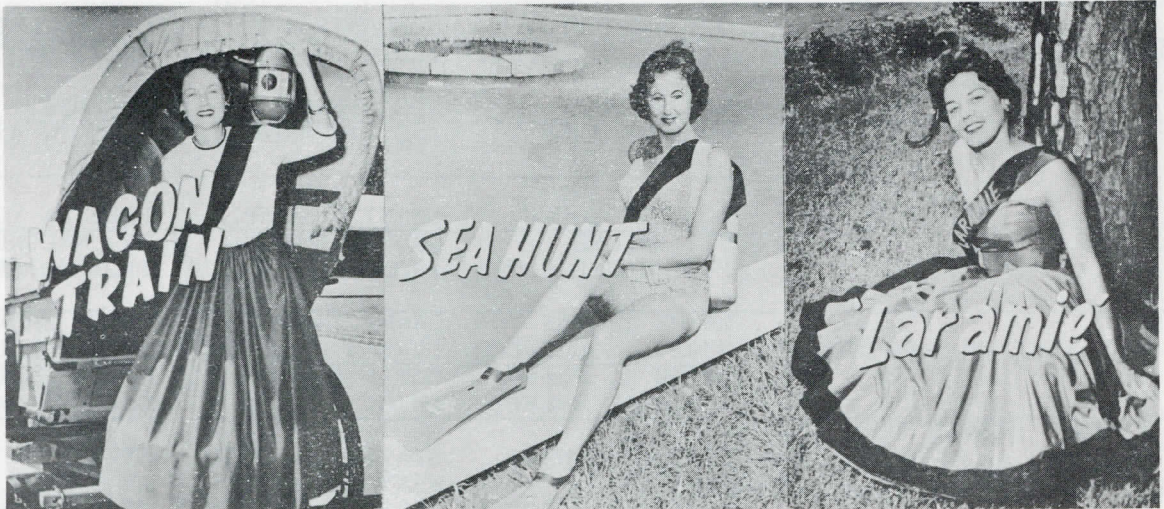

On October 20, 21 & 22, the RCA Color Unit will visit Channel 5. Watch for live color programming during that period. Visit us and see how you would look on color television. ■

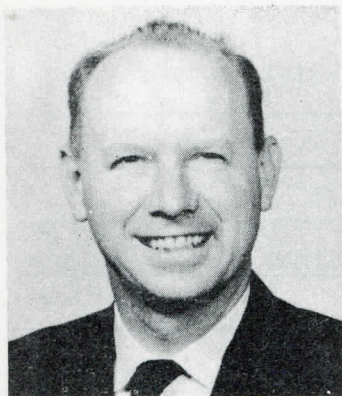
POPEYE RETURNS
